## Things To Do Before Your Appointment At Weston Eye Center

- If you have not completed a medical history form for
  Weston Eye Center within the last 30 days, please fill it out
  and bring with you to your appointment. This form will be
  included in this folder.
- Complete and sign the patient registration form (front & back).
- Read the six page informed consent. You will be given time during the next appointment to sign it.
- □ Complete and sign the Visual Function Scale.
- Make a list of any questions you have on the form provided in this folder.
- □ To help you remember the specific instructions at your appointment we suggest you bring someone with you.
- Your eye drop prescription will be electronically sent to the pharmacy of your choice. Please list the pharmacy here

## IMPORTANT!

Contact lenses may alter the shape of your eye which can change the pre-op measurements and, could affect the outcome of your surgery.

- No contact lens wear for at least 3 days prior to pre-op and do not resume wearing them until after your cataract surgery.
- A minimum of two weeks is required for the removal of hard or gas permeable contact lenses. Dr. Weston will determine the stability of your cornea on a case-by-case basis before proceeding with surgery.

To help ensure the best possible surgical outcome, please make sure our staff is fully aware of the exact date you stopped wearing your contact lenses.

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
